<u>Experiments planned</u>: HT/WT measurements, Beta/Gamma testing, EMF testing, Temperature testing, EEG, UV Lighting test, Full Spectrum camera testing, EVP questioning, SB7 questioning, and reading by sensitive.



Doll Facts:

Franklin Mint Heirloom FHD Victorian Porcelain Blonde Doll Limited Edition 1992 Vintage

Seller's description: "Jen

Her name is Jennifer, called Jen. She is 8 years old from a large family. She died from measles beautiful doll host as well as spirit she will talk on hacked radio and ghost speaker."



Testing results:

Weight: 1 pound 12.1 ounces

Height: 19 inches tall

Beta/gamma 17 CPM (0.0057 conversion = 0.0969 micro-

Sievert/hour (μSv/hr) Normal range)

 $0.0~\mu g~EMF$

Ambient temp: 65.2°F Doll temp: 65.1°F

No detectable brainwave activity – Note: EEG headset did not fit and may not have had complete contact.



Testing results (Cont.):

UV lighting test: No detectable anomalies

Full Spectrum camera test did not indicate anything unusual. Same as visible lighting.

EVP questioning (4 questions)

- 1. What is your name? No response.
- 2. Why are you with this doll? No response.
- 3. Is there anything you want or need to do? No response.
- 4. Is there anything you want to tell me? No response.

SB7 questioning (Same questions as above)

- 1. FM band fwd sweep 150ms. No response.
- 2. AM band fwd sweep 200ms. No response.

Impressions by Sensitive – KMJ:

- 1. Asian girl, 4, 5 or 6 years old.
- 2. Can't breathe/severe heaviness in chest.
- 3. Hidden/buried/suffocated.
- 4. Hearing "Tor" or "Tort."
- 5. Seeing the word "spine."

Conclusion: Insufficient evidence to prove or disprove haunting of doll.
